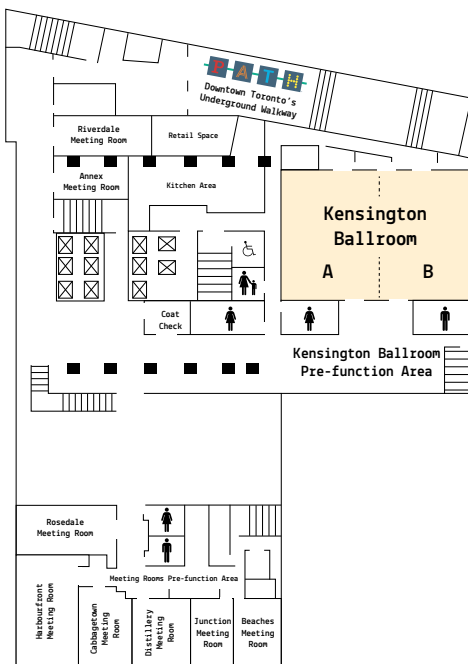

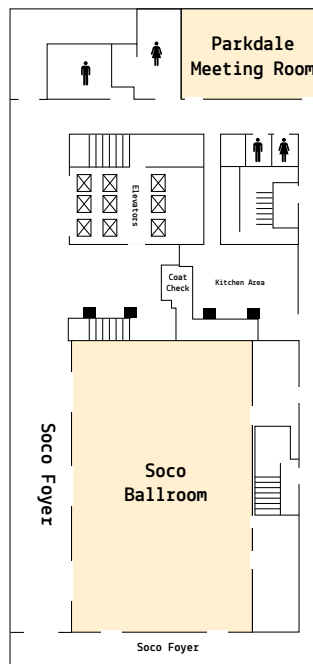
Keynote - Dr. Chika Stacy Oriuwa
