## Methodology

HEQCO's Pathways to French-language Institutions infographic is informed by research we conducted in 2024. HEQCO partnered with one publicly assisted French-language postsecondary institution in Ontario to survey current students about their decision to attend a French-language institution. The survey asked students about their French-language experiences and high school education, postsecondary preferences, factors that influenced their decision making and sociodemographic characteristics. Our questions asked respondents to reflect on the time when they first considered their options for postsecondary education (PSE) (i.e., during or after the final year of high school) to understand their initial postsecondary preferences and decisions.

The survey was administered online in the fall of 2024 and received 108 responses, including 90 complete and 18 incomplete responses. Respondents included individuals who were over 18 years old, could conduct a conversation in French during their final year of high school and first attended a French-language postsecondary institution in Ontario after high school. Although students who first attended any French-language postsecondary institution in Ontario could complete the survey, all respondents indicated the partner institution was their first PSE institution. Since participation in the survey was voluntary and the sample was not representative, survey findings cannot be generalized beyond the sample.
