- Program starts: **Jan. 12, 2026,** and it will end Apr. 28, 2026
- Method of delivery: virtual online
- Streams: Civil, Architecture
- Certificate of Accomplishment will be awarded upon completing all courses within the program
- 270 hours of subject time
 - Approx. 27 hours/week
 - 4 days during the week from 6:00pm-9:00pm (M,T, Th and Friday)
 - Saturday: 9-12 and 1-4
 - Wednesdays and Sundays: No Class
- Reading, practice, practice and active job search: 2 hours per day
 - Repeat Supported repetition and guided practice
